Our London Centre R.A.S.C. has appointed Mr. Langford Williams, of Teachers' College, London Ont, to take over the duties of the "Observing group" and he will be most appreciative to get your ephemeris in the future. I am very busy and cannot find the time, was taking over the presidency of the London Centre. The observing here this winter has been very bad, only 7 nights have been clear. I may have a notice in the near future on a meteorite which is in the possession of a person who I accidentally met. It weighs 18 lb and is approx. 10" x 6" in size. It appears very authentic, but the owner will not let me have it to test it at the University

by the geologist. This meteorite was found north of London, 75 to 100 years ago on the present owner's grandparents farm. It has never been catalogued or mentioned in any publications. I hope I will be able to forward slides to you on this very soon. It appears to me as a "Siderolite" type, high in nickel iron. Your comments will be appreciated on this item. Best in observing.
