Oct. 29 was a very clear night and my record shows Comet Kilston to be very faint at that time. Most of my observing time that night was spent trying to see Saturn's rings. Four moons but no rings could be seen.

I intended going to the General Assembly this year and then staying on the following week to visit Expo.
