- (c) Who might supply such material? In particular, would your Centre be willing to supply a regular correspondent to the newsletter? If so, please send me the name of such a correspondent.
- (d) Do you have any other suggestions regarding a) the newsletter or b) other possible activities of the Committee on Co-ordination of Centre Activities?
