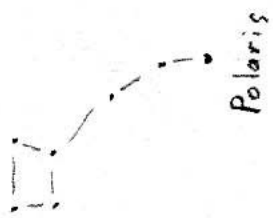
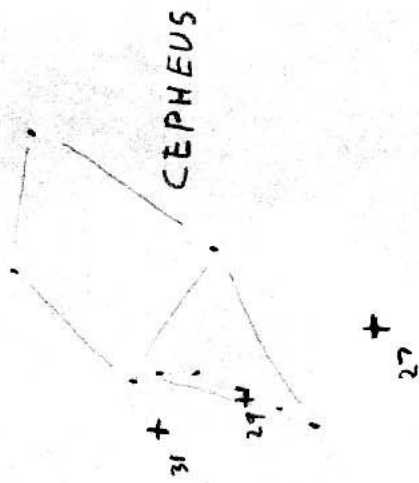
Enclosed you will find a chart showing the positions of the comet on each night.
