

Outreach to Others

Many groups in a community would enjoy astronomy outreach. Examples could be showing the moon or bright planets at evening gatherings (hockey games, car dealerships, parent nights at feeder schools) or day time solar observing (libraries, feeder schools, malls).



If permissions can be obtained and your club either has a night telescope or a solar telescope, it is useful for the club members to show off the sky. There might be some members of a local centre or astronomy club who might bring telescopes.

At events, perhaps some school club members might give talks and develop speaking skills. It is useful to have visual materials to give people waiting for a chance to look through the telescope.

Running events like this promotes your club, especially events at feeder schools to attract members for future years.
