The other half of J-Building is under construction...sorry about that.


FIRST AID / MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Student Centre (SC) - 2nd Floor




Should you require assistance outside of the Registration hours there will be contact information posted at the Main Registration and Concierge Desk (SC 2000).

A continental breakfast, in the Merlin House (R3) Atrium, is included with the price of accommodation.


D Building - 1st Floor







London Centre Fingal Observing Site



Members of London Centre enjoy dark skies near Fingal, approximately 40 kilometres south west of London. We operate two Roll Off Roof Observatories, equipped for Visual Observing and Astro-Imaging, plus a Heated Warm Up Room. During WWII this area was a bustling air force training base, the Number 4 Bombing and Gunnery School, and the huge concrete pad on which we park and set up telescopes was once the floor of aircraft hangar number 6.

Pig Out Under the Stars (POUTS) - Saturday

If you paid for the picnic on Saturday, we will provide transportation to the London Centre's observing site for an outdoor meal under the stars. Dress appropriately, bring bug juice. The observatories will be open for visitors. If the weather is sour, there will still be a Pig Out, but it will be in a church hall instead of Under the Stars. First bus will leave the circle in front of Merlin House, on the Fanshawe campus, at 17:30, or when it is full. Following busses leave when they are full.
