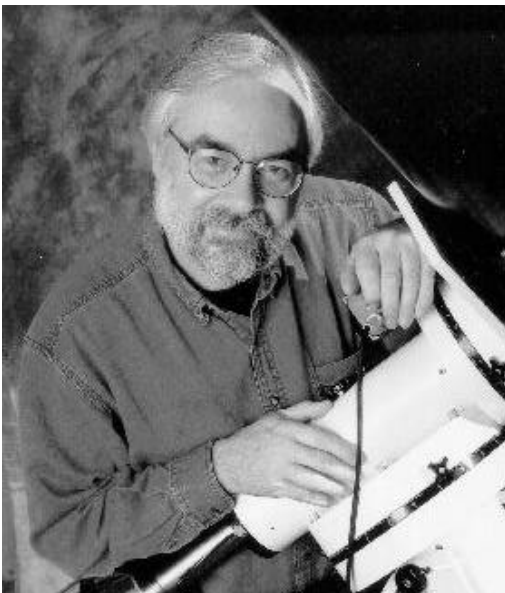

Terence Dickinson will present a **Public Slide Show**. Terry has been involved in astronomy full-time since 1967 as a prolific writer, a respected teacher, a knowledgeable broadcaster, an accomplished editor, and an excellent astro-photographer. He has edited the Canadian astronomy magazine SkyNews since its inception in 1995. His book NightWatch, now in its third edition and one of the best-selling astronomy books in the world, as well as 13 other astronomy books for adults and children, have fueled the public's growing interest in stargazing. His popular articles on astronomy appear in dozens of magazines, from Sky &

Telescope and Reader's Digest to Popular Mechanics. He is a weekly columnist for The Toronto Star and a regular commentator for the Canadian Discovery Channel and CBC Radio. Asteroid 5272 Dickinson is named after him. He is a Member of the Order of Canada, appointed by the Governor General in 1995 for his distinguished achievements in astronomy education. <http://www.skynewsmagazine.com/>
